## Request for Review under The Freedom Of Information (Scotland) Act 2002

Thank you for your request, in which you asked for a review of our response to the following point in your Freedom of Information request dated 7 May 2021:

The amount of funding awarded to each individual coach operator in the Scotland Coach Operators – COVID-19 Business Support and Continuity Fund – Strand One

I have reviewed the response you received to this request and can respond as follows:

When VisitScotland sent the response to your FOI request, we were unable to release the list of fund awardees and amounts as the list was not yet available at that time.


