Thank you for your request for information which was received by VisitScotland on 3 October 2024 at 6:12pm:

Could you provide an organisation chart for Digital and IT from Director down to management, including job titles and names, please.

VisitScotland’s response

Please find attached organisation charts for our IT function and for our Digital Delivery function.

Please note that we have included the names of colleagues who are employed in a senior management role, and we have taken out the names of employees below this level. It is VisitScotland’s policy to redact the personal information of colleagues below this level.

We consider that it would be unfair to release personal information on staff members below this level as these colleagues would have a greater expectation of privacy and would not expect their personal data to be processed in this manner. Disclosing their personal data would contravene the data protection principles in Article 5(1) of the UK General Data Protection Regulation and accordingly this information is considered by us to be exempt under Section 38 (1) (b) of the Act.

Your right to request a review

letter. Any request for a review should also set out, in as much detail as possible, the reasons why you are not satisfied with our response or the manner in which we have dealt with your application.

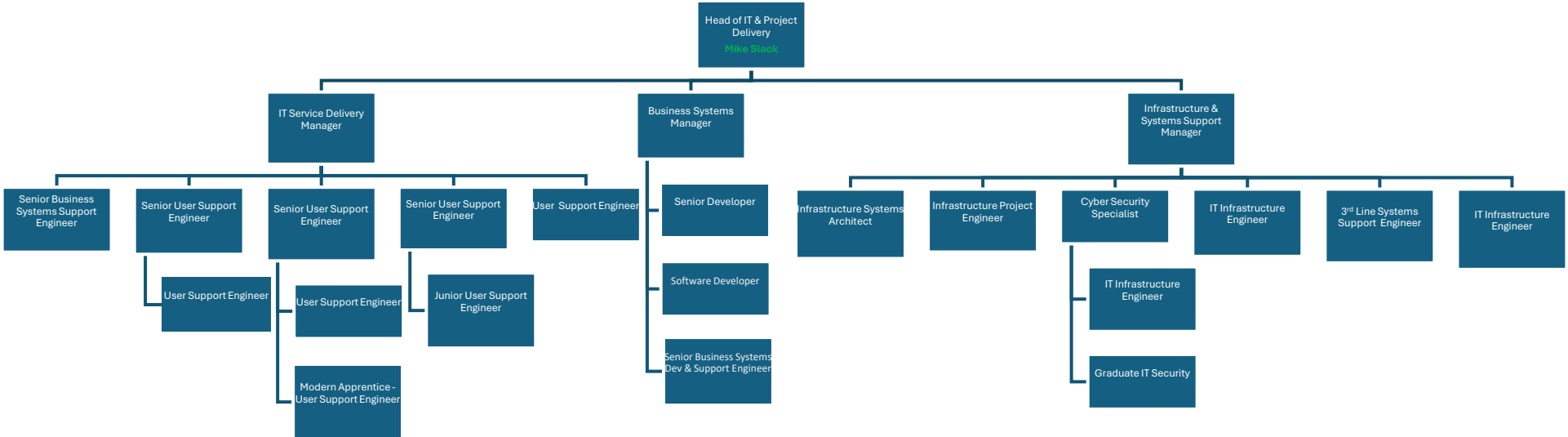
If you are not satisfied with the result of the review, then you have the right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner.
