Your Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (“the Act”) request

Thank you for your email which was received by VisitScotland on 27th March 2025 at 9.50am requesting information about:

“Please would you be able to let me know how I can find out how much public money has been awarded to Isle of Jura for tourism over the past 5 years from Visit Scotland. If not awarded to Isle of Jura specifically, then it might indeed come under 'Islay and Jura' collectively, but anything that has been awarded where Jura is concerned is the information we are after.”

VisitScotland’s Response

Over the past 5 years VisitScotland has paid a total of £43,800 to Jura. This sum includes a joint payment to Islay and Jura collectively. Payments include Covid grant funding which VisitScotland administered on behalf of The Scottish Government.
